**2 D Shape** - properties, angles, symmetry, congruence.

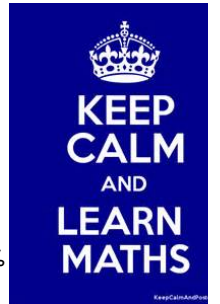
**3 D Shape** - properties, faces, edges, vertices.

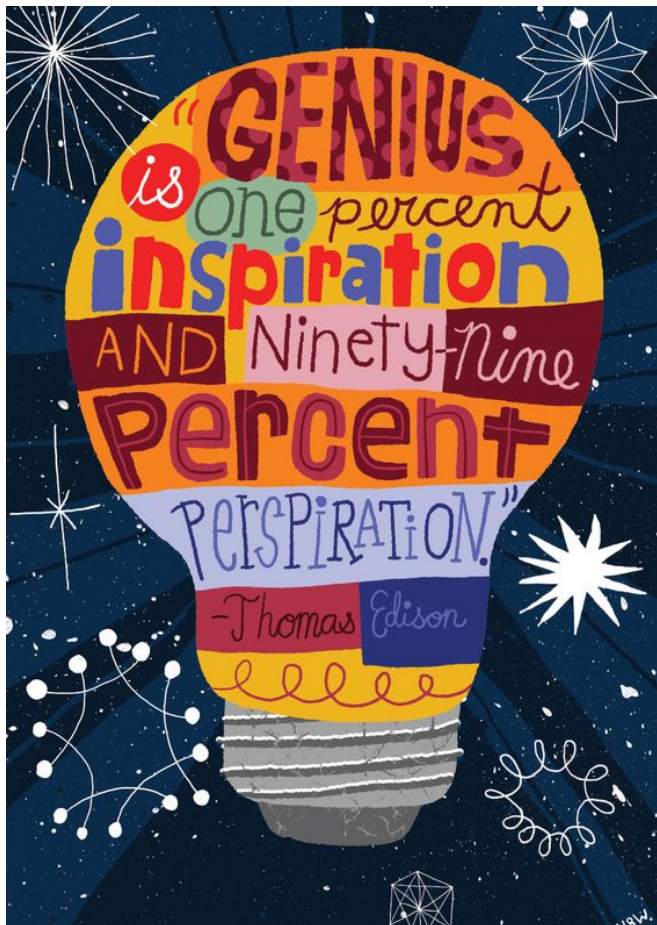
## Other Important Information
