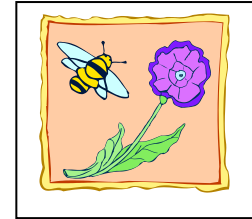


## Our Class News May & June 2019

warm!



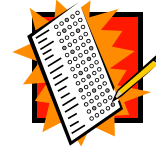
### Holidays

### May/June Curriculum Work

This is just a quick overview of the curriculum content that your child will be covering during this month.

Primary 1	Primary 2
<u>Numeracy</u> Learn all about measure - length/weight/capacity. Revise all number work to 10. Revise all number to 10 formation. Revise basic shapes, time and money.	<u>Numeracy</u> Revise number knowledge to 20 - writing numbers, counting groups of objects, adding two groups together. Revise all shape work, time and money. Investigate the topics of measures - length/weight and capacity.
<u>Literacy</u> Revise all lower case letter formation Revise all initial sounds and the name of the letters. Revise all P1 high Frequency Words Be able to match initial letters to a picture that begins with the given sound.	<u>Literacy</u> Revise all sounds and initial clusters Revise spellings from list for class test. Revise alphabetical order and how to use it.

#### The following areas are done together (P1/2)

PDMU - Feelings - how to recognise an oh-oh feeling! How also to feel safe - what makes us feel safe!

- Drawing up a helping hand of people we can talk to if we do not feel safe or happy.

RE - Finish our Bible Time booklets

PE - Team games - working together - Sports day Practise

Music - Seasonal songs to use in Assembly

Use of percussion instruments to accompany songs we are learning.
